E-scooter

An e-scooter is an electric scooter. It is similar to a two-wheeled manual scooter, except it has a motor. They run on rechargeable batteries, so you need to plug it in to charge it (a bit like a mobile phone).



E-scooters often have a lightweight folding frame.



Can you spot the brake on this e-scooter?



An e-scooter usually has a stop and start button, a throttle to accelerate and a brake to decelerate.



It is against the law to use a privately owned escooter unless you are on private land. The trial escooters can only be used on roads (not motorways) and cycle lanes and paths.
