The COP26 climate summit, one of the biggest ever world meetings on how to tackle climate change, is taking place between 31<sup>st</sup> October and 12<sup>th</sup> November 2021 and is being held in Glasgow. Prior to the summit, most countries set out their plans to reduce emissions. The Queen spoke out before the start of the event, saying she is irritated by the lack of progress on climate issues. The 95-year-old monarch spoke after the opening of the Senedd in Cardiff as she criticised those who "talk but don't do".
