Dolphin facts

- Dolphins live in water, either the ocean or rivers.
- They eat a variety of food including fish, squid, plankton, octopus.
- On average, they can hold their breath for 10 minutes.
- There are about 40 different species of dolphin.
- A group of dolphins is called a pod. Dolphins are very social mammals that swim together, catch their food as a team and play together.
